

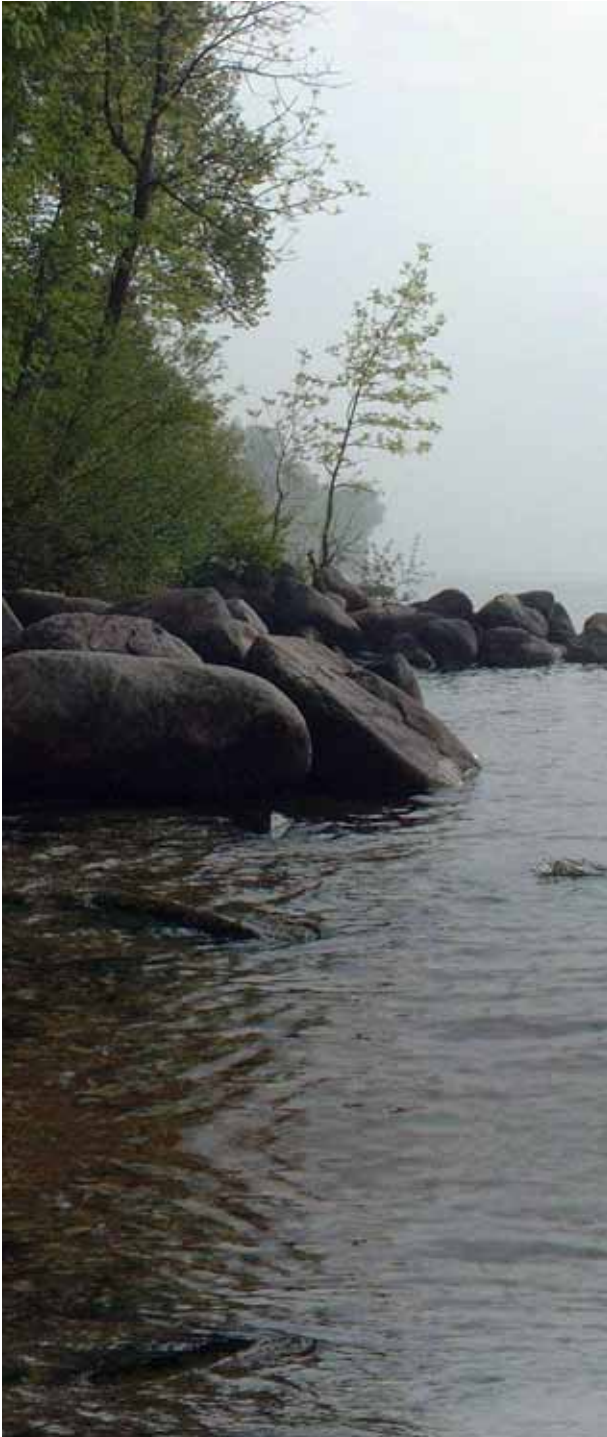

Improve water quality and fish habitat in Lake Simcoe, its rivers and streams

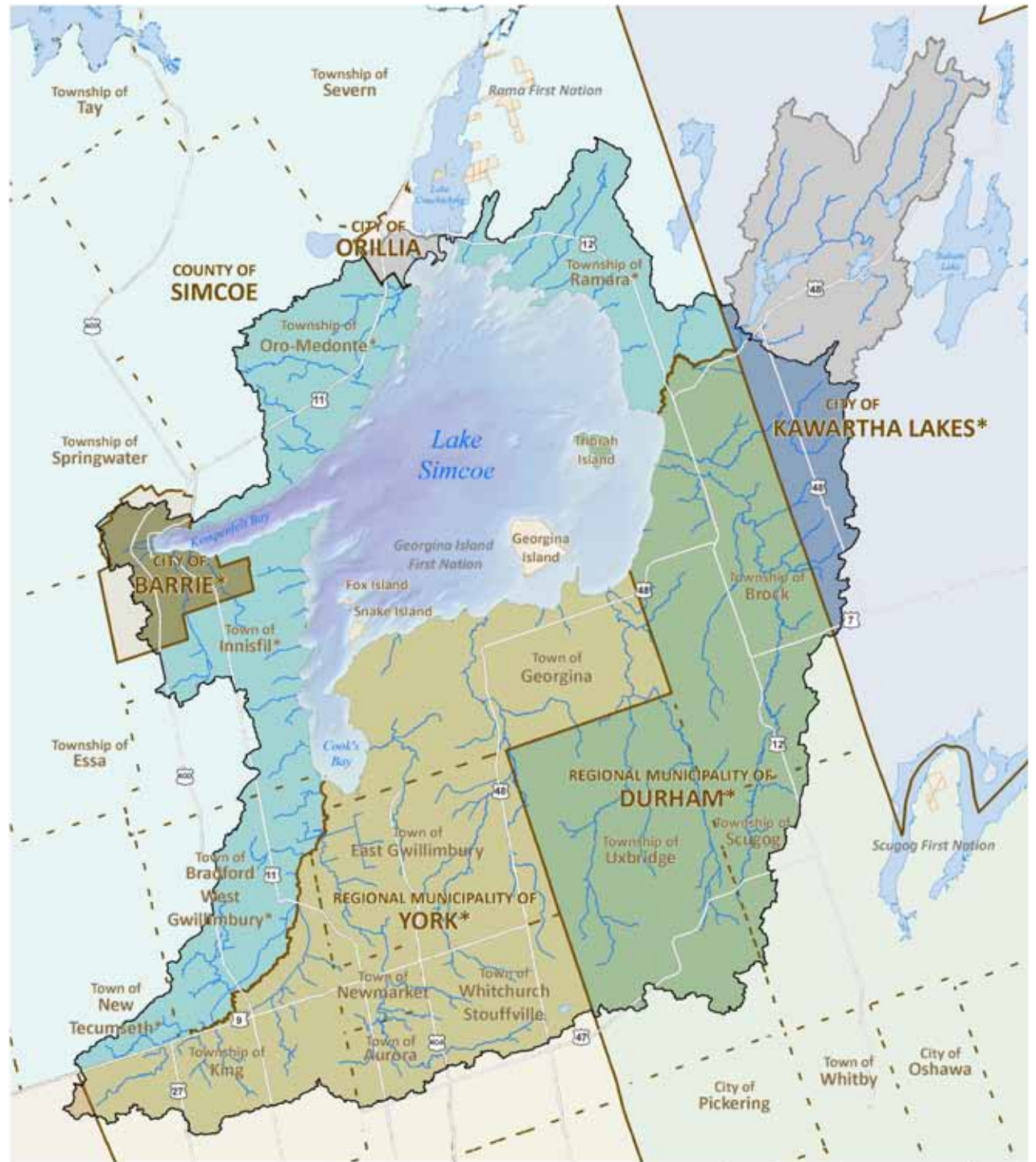
Reduce invasive aquatic plant growth in Lake Simcoe, its rivers and streams
